A quality award

The European Diploma (**D.E.C.**) and the European Diploma in Languages for Business (**DECLA**) are quality qualifications which recognise a high level of achievement in European Studies and which meet the requirements of European directives on the recognition and equivalency of awards.

The European Diploma (D.E.C.): For primary and secondary schools.

This is awarded on successful completion of 3 compulsory units:

- Achievement in foreign language learning (pre-16 and post-16),
- Knowledge about Europe (culture and institutions),
- Residence abroad.

The European Diploma for Languages in Business (DECLA): For colleges of higher and further education.

- This is awarded on successful completion of exams in the language and culture of the business world.

These European Diplomas offer an additional qualification, which rewards academic and vocational study.
